* A critical part of the application for NIH conference support is the documentation of appropriate representation of women, racial/ethnic minorities**, persons with disabilities***, and other individuals who have been traditionally underrepresented in science. While not required, self-identification will help us perpetuate funding for future Clostridium conferences.

** There are two ethnic categories -- Hispanic or Latino and Not Hispanic or Latino – and five racial categories -- American Indian or Alaskan Native, Asian, Black or African American, Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, and White. Whites are defined as the majority group; the remaining categories comprise the racial/ethnic minorities. The classification of an individual is by self-identification.

*** A person with a disability means any person who (a) has a physical or mental impairment which substantially limits one or more of such person's major life activities; (b) has a record of such an impairment; or (c) is regarded as having such an impairment, as described under section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
